

WEAVEonline Reports

You can run several reports in WEAVE that will help you move through the process.

Detailed Assessment Report—provides all of the text of your assessment plan. When you click on the Next button you, you can select specific items you want to view, or you can include everything by default.

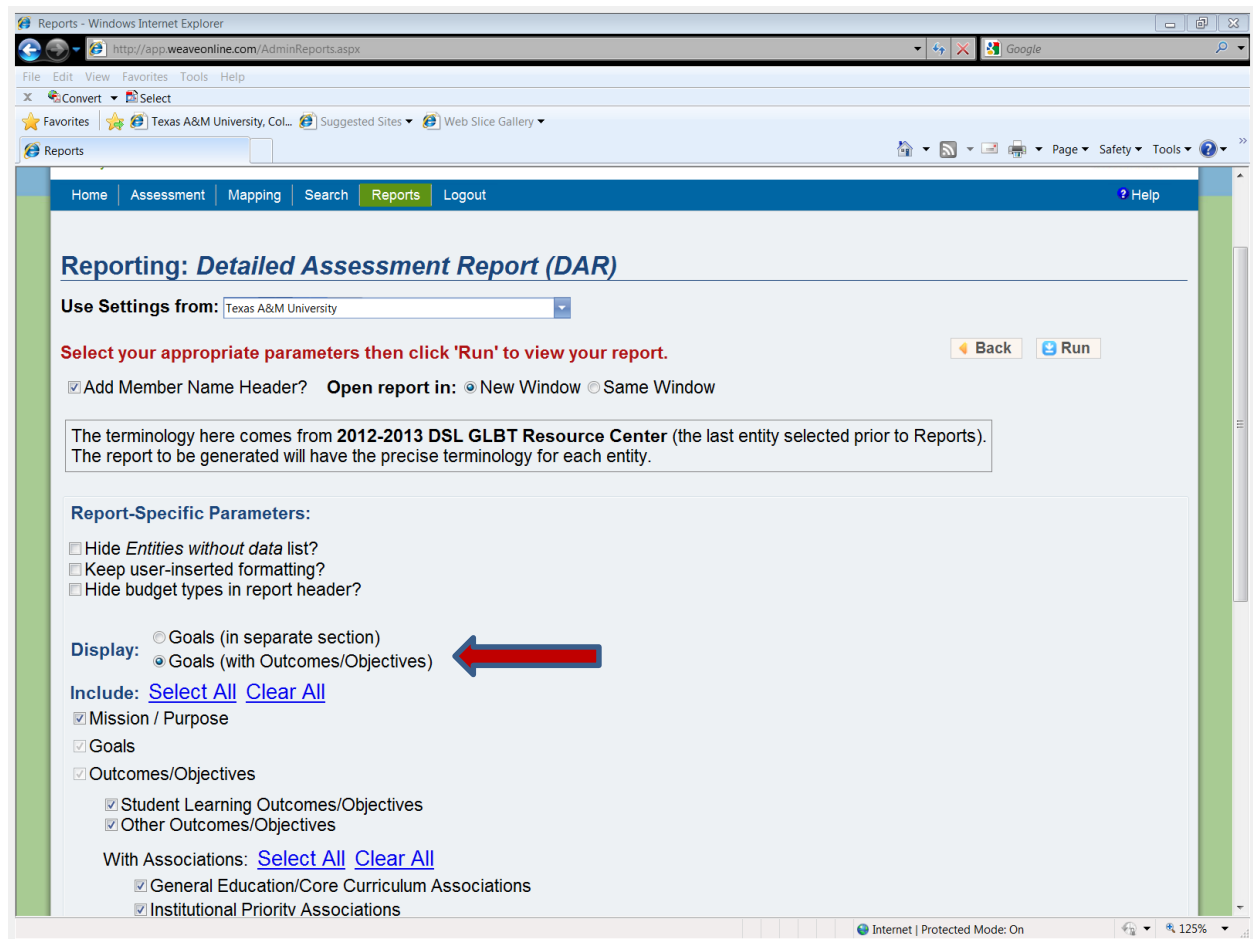

1 When you run the DAR, you probably want to display the Goals with the Objectives/Outcomes (see the arrow). Be sure to click on the button to do that. Feel free to check/uncheck buttons and boxes that will help you. Hit the Run button to produce the report.



2 The Audit Reports are useful to find out what you might be missing in your plan. There are several to choose from. It's good practice to run all of them when you complete different steps in your plan. These reports sometimes illustrate an internal WEAVE error; if you think that is the case, contact Student Life Studies.

3 The DES Reports are a fast report to see what has been marked Final, In Progress, or None (not started). Be careful, though, because this report is not always completely accurate for every entry that you will need to mark Final.

The other reports on the page can also be helpful for specific questions you might have. Feel free to play around and run any report that might interest you.
